

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING LEVEL 4 EXAMS DURING THE LATEST LOCKDOWN

Dear learners,

As the national lockdowns are in place across the UK, it is clear that these restrictions will continue into March and subsequently through the next exam window for Level 4 exams. Therefore, **we have decided to cancel the next examination window (Monday 22 February 2021 - Saturday 13 March 2021) to ensure everyone's safety.**

Those who have booked with Pearson Vue will be able to reschedule for a later date. They will contact you directly with instructions on how to do this.

As a result of this announcement, we will be extending the September and December 2021 exam windows to allow for any deferrals, this is combined with the extended window in June 2021 that is already on offer.

We will ensure that your registrations remain open and be extended free of charge where applicable. Candidates are advised to monitor and review the availability of Pearson Vue test centres in light of any future localised or national lockdowns.
